Proposed Amendments to IPA IT Charter (by Thailand Delegation)
As of 19 May 2004

Article 3 (Composition)

(existing provision) “Membership of IPA IT shall be composed of parliamentarians from their respective National Parliaments.”

(proposed amendments) “Membership of IPA IT shall be composed of parliamentarians from their respective National Parliaments. **Each Parliament shall designate an official national chapter which will bring more participation and continuity in the activities of IPA IT.**”

Article 17 (Official Languages)

(existing provision) “The official languages of IPA IT shall be English and the official language of the host country and all documents shall be drawn up in the official languages. However in the event the interpretation and meaning are different, the English interpretation and meaning shall be taken into consideration.”

(proposed amendments) “The official languages of IPA IT shall be English and the official language of the host country and all documents shall be drawn up in the official languages. **The official languages where deemed appropriate shall be used in the creation of webpages of the official website of each national parliament.** However in the event the interpretation and meaning are different, the English interpretation and meaning shall be taken into consideration.”
